A summary of each of our programmes follows:

Disney's "The Little Mermaid"

In April, we made the difficult decision to pause rehearsals, and postpone our production of Disney's "The Little Mermaid" until November. This involved cancelling our second programme of the year, but was definitely the best outcome for our community.

With the impending move to Level 1, we have scheduled to **restart rehearsals on the weekend of September 12th & 13th**, more information will be sent out to our cast as it becomes available. This will lead up to our performances at The Aotea Centre from **November 26th to 29th**.

The extra resources we created during the lockdown will be used to ensure all rehearsal material is available online. This will enable any castmembers who are feeling unwell to stay away from rehearsal without missing out.
